Nathan Volke Announces Run for County Council
Pasadena Republican Enters 2018 District 3 Race

Pasadena, Maryland (November 17, 2016) — Joined by family, friends and community leaders, Nathan Volke today officially announced his candidacy for the Anne Arundel County Council in District 3 in 2018. Councilman Derek Fink currently serves in this position, which will be vacated due to term limits.

“As a lifelong resident of Pasadena, I have always loved our community. My wife and I have chosen to build our life here, close to our family and friends, most of whom have lived here for generations,” said Nathan. “Running for County Council is a chance to serve our community as an advocate, strengthening our neighborhoods and ensuring that Pasadena remains a great place to live and raise a family for generations to come.”

Nathan graduated from Chesapeake High School, where he met his future wife, Kristi. He studied political science at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County and received a law degree from the University of Baltimore at age 23. He now works full-time as an attorney in private practice in Annapolis.

For more than a decade, Nathan has spent much of his free time in community and political activism. Nathan was elected in 2010 and re-elected in 2014 to the Anne Arundel County Republican Central Committee, and served as its chairman from 2013 to 2016. In this volunteer position, Nathan worked with elected officials to increase voter registration and assist candidates running for office. In addition, Nathan has been a volunteer Community Liaison for Delegate Nic Kipke and served on the Office of Law Transition Team for County Executive Steve Schuh.

A solid conservative, Nathan is a member of the National Rifle Association (NRA) and the North County Republican Club.
